I think this is maybe the best Quartier Chardonnay to date. It's from Dromana, Main Ridge and Balnarring. 12% new oak. A juicy and fruity style, pear, nectarine and fresh strawberry, fennel, a kiss of cedar oak and spice. It has a fine chalky feel to texture, balanced acidity, a light sour yoghurt creaminess, and finish of good length, a little green olive and lemon zest to close. Easy to enjoy. A pleasing glass of Chardonnay.
